The SDGs encompass 17 interconnected goals that cover a wide range of issues. including poverty, hunger, education, gender equality, clean water and sanitation, affordable and clean energy, decent work and economic growth, sustainable cities and communities, climate action, and more. These goals aim to create a sustainable and equitable future for everyone, leaving no one behind.

It is crucial to follow the SDGs, for they provide a comprehensive framework that guides governments, organizations, and individuals in their efforts to achieve sustainable development. SDGs can help create a more inclusive and equitable society. The goals emphasize the importance of eradicating poverty, reducing inequalities, promoting education, and ensuring access to basicservices for all.By aligning their actions with the SDGs, countries can set targets, develop policies, and allocate resources effectively to address the most pressing challenges of our time.

SUEZ Foundation-India strives to achieve these objectives, to foster social cohesion and empower marginalized communities.

#### 1 Supplementing Education: A Holistic Course

One of the key focus areas, the Foundation has contributed towards the upliftment of underprivileged youth in India by extending support towards:

- Long term educational promotion projects, in partnership with schools and civil society organizations.
- Academic and professional courses for underprivileged scholars
- Schools and institutions for the differently abled children.

#### 2 Empowerment of Women: Skilling for Success

Women empowerment has been one of the main pillars of our CSR initiatives, which the Foundation intends to achieve by ensuring equal opportunities for women in education and skill development. To bridge the gender gaps in various socioeconomic indicators, it has been our objective to initiate and ensure:

- Merit cum means scholarship for higher education for girls
- Vocational/Skill development programs
- Infrastructural support for women ITIs and vocational training
- Career counselling and job placements

#### 3 Protecting the Environment

Being a global organization providing access to one of the most important natural resources, we adopt conservation and protection of the environment as one of our main responsibilities. The Foundation supports projects that work for watershed management, rainwater harvesting, soil conservation and sustainable agriculture initiatives. Environmental awareness programs such as tree plantations and graffiti painting are some of the activities organized by the Foundation to sensitize the communities about the importance of protecting the Environment.

#### 4 Humanitarian Support: Helping Hands

The Foundation has previously helped the people in unfortunate times like that of COVID-19, Kerala floods and will continue to support society in times of need.

#### 5 Transforming WASH

The Foundation intends to provide full support to the Government of India for its numerous initiatives on cleanliness and sanitation. We have a special focus on creating awareness on the same among school children and urban slums. We aim to encourage SUEZ employees volunteering programs with focus on:

- · WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) education in schools.
- Supporting Swachh Bharat Abhiyan and other state led programs on WASH.
- · Organizing rallies and cultural events to create awareness around WASH.





## VIGYANSHAALA | New Delhi & Uttarakhand

SHE for STEM

The Foundation joined hands with VigyanShaala, an NGO that works towards advancement of STEM education in India, with an objective to enable the innovators of tomorrow to achieve their dreams by bringing science, technology and learning to their doorstep today.

Project Kalpana is a multiple awardwinning mentoring and career readiness programmes designed by scientists and professionals at VigyaanShaala, with a vision to close the gender gap in STEM and nurture the next generation of women STEM leaders from the most marginalised

communities across India. The project consists of two-level

fellowship, Kalpana incubator and Kalpana Accelerator. The Kalpana Incubator provides 50+ hours of intensive learning, spread over 3 months, enabling the fellows to get more clarity, conviction and confidence about their career paths in STEM.

The Kalpana Accelerator provides the fellows with 120+ hrs of intensive learning, spread over 12-14 weeks, on personalised career coaching and mentoring from a leading global STEM professional. This helps in supporting the fellows in narrowing down a unique focus in the STEM industry. SUEZ Foundation-India is sponsoring the education of 300 girls across India via project Kalpana. The Foundation aims to assist VigyanShaala in their mission to mentor 10.000 girls that wish to start a career in STEM but are unable to do so because of numerous socio-economic barriers.

## SARTHAK EDUCATIONAL TRUST | New Delhi

**Equipping and Empowering with Employability** 

Sarthak Educational Trust is an organisation working dedicatedly for the PwDs. i.e., persons with disabilities. The organisation, through its interventions, has been able to change the lives of approximately 78,000 PwDs via training and job placement.

SUEZ Foundation - India supported the skill development of 10 PwDs in 2022, by providing financial support to Sarthak Educational Trust's JEET program.

JEET (Job Entrepreneurship and Empowerment Training) provides vocational skill enhancement training to people between the ages of 18 - 35, so that they can create sustainable livelihoods for themselves. The program provides basic skill building training as well as provides numerous opportunities for learning specific trades like IT, hospitality. retail etc., depending on the interest and prior experience of the individual.

#### Impact Story

Ehtesham comes from an underprivileged background and has a locomotor impairment of 40%. Because of financial constraints, he was looking for work but was unable to find employment because of his disability.

Sarthak Educational Trust reached out to him and registered him for the JEET program. Initially reluctant and nervous, by the end of the training, his communication skills improved, his self-confidence grew, and he wished to

be a good employee. Post training, he got a position at Concentrix as a Customer Care Associate with a salary of Rs. 14.167 per month. Ehtesham told Sarthak that he is pleased because he can earn money and support his family. He is grateful to SUEZ Foundation - India & Sarthak Educational Trust for assisting him and providing wonderful training for physically challenged people so that they can acquire knowledge and live independently.

## SOS CHILDREN'S VILLAGES OF INDIA

Faridabad & Coimbatore

No Child Alone

SOS Children's Villages is an international organisation providing care and protection to children across 136 countries. In India. the 32 SOS children's villages across 22 states cater to over 25.000 children.

The organisation supports children who are orphaned, abandoned, or whose families are unable to care for them. Their approach is based on four principles: Each child needs a mother, and grows up most naturally with brothers and sisters, in their own house, within a supportive village environment

SUEZ Foundation - India has been supporting the higher education of 5 girls, ever since the collaboration started in 2019. In 2022, the Foundation expanded the financial support for the education of 4 more girls, under the Project Empower.

#### **Impact Story**

Karissma, 20, became a part of SOS Children's Village - Greenfields in the vear 2009. She was an active child and completed her schooling successfully. Through the educational support provided by the Foundation, Karissma is now pursuing Bachelor of Business Administration from Trinity Institute of Innovations and Professional Studies. She aspires to become a successful businesswoman in future and is dedicated towards her course and career. The Foundation is proud of her achievements and wishes her a successful career in entrepreneurship!

Poongodi, 21, came to SOS Children's Village - Chennai in the vear 2006, at a budding age of 5 vears. Since childhood, she has been an outstanding academic performer and an active participant in extracurriculars held in the village and her school. Poongodi is now pursuing MBA from Dhanalakshmi College and has secured 'A' grade in her latest exams. The Foundation provided her with tuition assistance in different subjects. The Foundation shall continue to support bright young minds like Poongodi.



### SMILE TRAIN INDIA

Changing the World, One Smile at a Time

Smile Train is the largest cleft-focused organization with a model of true sustainability - providing training. funding, and resources to empower local medical professionals in 70+ countries to provide 100%-free cleft surgery and other forms of essential cleft care in their own communities.

SUEZ Foundation India joined hands with Smile Train in November, 2019 and since then the partnership has supported 64 children from underprivileged backgrounds in getting new smiles and new chances. These surgeries have not only helped

the children overcome their facial birth differences, but more importantly, has also helped the children join the mainstream of society with an equal opportunity to be productive and contributing members of the society.

This partnership provides high quality. safe and totally free corrective surgeries to underprivileged beneficiaries born with cleft lip and/or palate at Smile Train Partner hospital in NCR Delhi.

Since the partnership started in November 2019, 24 have got new smiles and second chances in life. In the period, November 2022 - March 2023, the grant has supported another 40 free surgeries and new smiles to underprivileged cleft patients through this valuable partnership.

These surgeries have not only helped the children overcome their facial birth difference, but more importantly, will help the children join the mainstream of society with an equal opportunity to go to school, learn a trade, earn a living, get married, and be productive and contributing members of the society.







#### **FACTS & FIGURES**

- 30 % of the beneficiaries are girls.
- All the beneficiaries are children. 83% of the children are aged 2 years and below.
- 55 % of the beneficiaries were provided surgery for Cleft Lip Nose repair.
- 45% of the beneficiaries were provided surgery for Cleft Palate repair.
