Isabelle Calvez was appointed Senior VP of Human Resources at SUEZ Group on 18 April. A graduate of the Institut d'Etudes Politiques in Paris, she began her career at Thales Group, before joining the Canal+ Group, then the Accenture Group, and becoming Human Resources VP at Groupama in 2007. Isabelle Calvez has been Human Resources VP at Carrefour France since 2012.

She succeeds Denys Neymon and is a member of the SUEZ Executive Committee.

Denys Neymon is dedicating himself to his position of CEO of the Water and Waste Treatment Infrastructures Global Business Line, which he has been managing since September 2015, and will support SUEZ's transformation with Jean-Yves Larrouturou. Denys Neymon was the Human Resources VP of Bouygues Bâtiment for 10 years, before becoming the Human Resources VP of SUEZ in 2004. He has supported the major transformations of SUEZ, including the stock market listing in 2008, the end of the shareholders' agreement in 2013 and the transition to a single brand in 2015. He is a member of the SUEZ Executive Committee.

We are in the era of the resource revolution. In a world facing high demographic growth, runaway urbanisation and the scarcity of natural resources, securing, optimising and renewing resources is essential for our future. SUEZ (Paris: SEV, Brussels: SEVB) delivers wastewater treatment services to 58 million people and reuses 882 million m³ of wastewater. SUEZ also recovers 16.9 million tons of waste a year, produces 3.9 million tons of secondary raw materials and 7 TWh of local renewable energy. Finally, SUEZ avoids 9.5 MtCO₂e GHG emissions for its customers. With 83,921 employees, SUEZ is present on five continents and is a key player in the circular economy for the sustainable management of resources. SUEZ generated total revenues of 15.3 billion euros in 2016.
