

INFORMATION NOTICE

The personal data collected in connection with the #Passion4Environment photo contest are processed by the Commitment and Communications Division of SUEZ Group (SUEZ) and The Explorers, in their capacity as data controllers, having their registered office at Tour CB21, 16 Place de l'Iris, 92040 Paris La Défense Cedex, France.

Purpose of the processing

The purpose of the processing is to award prizes to the winners at the end of the photo contest.

Legal Basis

This processing is based on obtaining the winners' consent.

Categories of data processed

The categories of personal data collected directly from the winners by the Engagement and Communications Division of SUEZ are as follows:

- Surname
- First name
- Username on social networks
- Personal email address, for the 10 winners only

Mandatory or optional nature of the data collection

Collection of the data is necessary for the processing to be carried out.

Automated decision-making

The processing does not provide for automated decision-making.

Data subjects

The data processing concerns the winners.

Data recipients:

The personal data collected are intended for use by the Commitment and Communications Division of SUEZ and by The Explorers, to enable the winners to access the The Explorers platform. The data collected are not used for any other purposes, such as marketing in particular.

Transfers of data outside the EU

No data is transferred outside the European Union.

Retention period

The personal data collected are retained for the time required to process them, i.e. from 5 June to 5 July 2020, until the awarding of the prizes.

Your rights

In accordance with the regulations applicable regarding personal data, you have the right to access, rectification, restriction of processing, withdrawal of consent, erasure and portability regarding your data, which you can exercise by sending an email to pole.digital@suez.com or by sending a letter to the Engagement and Communications Division of SUEZ (Tour CB21, 16 place de l'Iris, 92040 La Défense Cedex, France), indicating your surname, first name and address, and attaching a copy of both sides of your identity papers.
